How do I submit the paper?

The researcher needs to submit through our online submission system(<u>click here</u>). If she/he can not submit through our system, she/he needs to email the paper to <u>ejebsjournal@gmail.com</u>. Editorial support staff shall acknowledge the receipt of the manuscript within 48 hours. Detailed information is available on the <u>Call for Paper</u> page

How to correct experimental data in my published paper?

Contact the editorial team at <u>ejebsjournal@gmail.com</u>. Mention the changes and provide the revised manuscript. The revised manuscript shall be published by **EJEBS article policies.**

I haven't received any EJEBS notification even after 30 days of submission!

Depending on your spam filter settings the notification email may be directed to your spam folder rather than your inbox. If this is not the case, we request you to escalate the issue to ejebsjournal@gmail.com. You shall be informed of the status within 48 hours.

Do I need to submit the copyright form along with the manuscript?

No, copyright forms shall be accepted by EJEBS only if the submission is accepted for publication.

My paper exceeds 15 pages!

IJEAIS policies allow the publication of a paper consisting of a maximum of 15 pages. However, depending upon the merit of the research, appropriate relaxations are granted by the EJEBS editorial panels.

How much time is needed to publish the proceedings?

EJEBS-type setting teams shall require a minimum of 15 days (from the date of submission of the proceedings papers) to complete the publication process in online formats.

How much time to complete a review?

Each submission undergoes detailed review by appointed domain experts and peer-reviews by domain peers. The entire process takes 10-30 days or more, to complete the review process.

Is there any particular paper format?

EJEBS recommends the conference organizers accept the final papers according to the <u>EJEBS</u>

<u>Manuscript Template</u> The set of papers should be submitted to EJEBS in **DOC/DOCX** format.
