

Publication Ethics Policy

Publication ethical standards are in place to uphold the reliability and quality of scientific research publications, foster public trust in scientific findings, and ensure that researchers receive due credit for their work and ideas. The EJEBS abides by a rigorous Code of Conduct and endeavors to follow its Best Practice Guidelines.

Plagiarism: All content disseminated by (EJEBS) is dedicated to featuring exclusively original material, meaning it has not been previously published elsewhere nor is currently under review elsewhere. In the event of plagiarism, all authors, including the corresponding authors, are barred from submitting papers to our journal for three years. Even if a paper has already been published, it will be retracted, with this action prominently displayed on the journal's homepage.

Duplicate Submission: Manuscripts discovered to have been previously published or under review elsewhere will face penalties for duplicate submission. If authors utilize their own previously published work or work currently under review as the foundation for a submitted manuscript, they must reference the prior work and demonstrate how their submission adds new insights beyond those of the previous work.

Improper Author Contribution or Attribution: Every author listed must have contributed substantially to the scientific research presented in the manuscript and endorsed all its assertions. It's crucial to acknowledge all individuals who made noteworthy scientific contributions, including students and laboratory technicians.

Redundant Publications: Redundant publications involve the inappropriate division of study outcomes into several articles.

Citation Manipulation: Manuscripts submitted with citations primarily intended to artificially inflate the citation count of a specific author's work or articles from a particular journal will face penalties for citation manipulation.

Data Fabrication & Falsification: Manuscripts found to contain fabricated or falsified experimental results, including manipulated images, will be penalized for data fabrication and falsification.

Penalty: Any documented violations of the aforementioned policies of (EJEBS), irrespective of whether they occurred within a journal published by (EJEBS), will be subject to the following penalties:

- Immediate rejection of the offending manuscript.
- Immediate rejection of any other manuscript submitted to any journal under the auspices of (EJEBS) by any of the authors of the offending manuscript.
- Prohibition against all authors from making any new submissions to (EJEBS), whether individually or collaboratively with other authors of the offending manuscript, as well as in conjunction with any other authors. This prohibition will be enforced for a minimum of 2 years.
- Prohibition against all authors from serving on the Editorial Board of (EJEBS).
- In cases where violations of the above policies are deemed particularly egregious, the publisher reserves the right to impose additional sanctions beyond those outlined above.
